Post-Harvest Report

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A registered grower shall submit this post-harvest report not later than 60 days after receiving delta-9-THC sampling results (must test at or below 0.3 percent) from the division. This report is due for each and every address in your Grower Registration Agreement and must include every field or indoor planted area identified in your Registration Agreement. Use separate forms for different addresses.

Directions: Complete all parts of the following form and submit the report and all required attachments to Alaska Plant Materials Center Hemp Program, 5310 S. Bodenbug Spur, Palmer, AK 99645. The report must be complete, accurate and legible. Follow all instructions in the document. Be sure to keep a copy of the full report for your records.
